
Indoor Worship Protocols for LCOR, August 2020

- ✘ Please maintain social distance of approximately 6 ft. whenever possible per Executive Order 7N11
- ✘ Masks shall be worn in the sanctuary and hallway when you are not a safe social distance of 6 feet per Executive Order 7N11
- ✘ Please only sit in the open pews. There will be an open pew in front and behind you. Families sit together without social distancing. Others please social distance in the pews. Blue tape marks approximately each 6-foot mark.
- ✘ The usher(s) will wear gloves and a mask to hand out worship folders. Worship folders are single use. Please take them home or place in the marked recycling bin.
- ✘ The offering plate is placed on the ushers' table at the back of the sanctuary. You may leave your offering to the Lord there before or after the service. The plates will not be passed during the service.
- ✘ Holy Communion
 - We will not use the common cup for the Distribution.
 - Pastor and assistant will wear gloves and a mask for the Distribution.
 - The Distribution will be done in continuous fashion, leaving social distance between families/members. You will be ushered up by family/pew. Come forward to receive the Host from the Pastor and then take an individual cup from the assistant. We will not kneel at the Table. Used cups will be placed in the designated place. The Dismissal will be spoken once everyone has communed.
- ✘ There is hand sanitizer available. Please do not take them from the pews.
- ✘ No handshakes, hugging, or physical contact.
- ✘ Wash your hands after using the restroom for at least 20 seconds.
- ✘ Maintain social distance when you are in the building to the extent that is possible.
- ✘ No greeters or readers will be serving at this time.
- ✘ No coffee hour.
- ✘ Pews and door handles will be sanitized after each service.

What If I'm Not Comfortable Coming to Worship Yet?

If you are uncomfortable coming to in-person worship, we understand! The Lord understands! There is no pressure to attend! We want you comfortable and safe.

We will continue to provide live stream and video for the services. The 8 a.m. service will be live streamed each week. You can participate live at that time or view the recording and worship at a time convenient for you and your family.
